Steering Committee

- 1 member per country (contact person)
- It is a commission of supervision - (supervises the deadlines)
- It prepares an internal report
- In the first meeting explains the financial rules
- It has the general picture of all the produced documents
- makes a list of activities to be monitored to see milestones , progress
- defines the objectives and check if the result is consistent with the target
- Prepares the evaluation grids for the hunts (group and individual) - meets one time per month

Operating committee

- 1 or 2 members of each country
- It manages the project day by day
- collects information on the effectiveness of the project
- Plans focus groups type meetings and checks: improving skills and knowledge of the involved people - success rate - satisfaction questionnaire on project organization and performance.
- At each step picks materials and prepare a summary to be delivered to the steering ; annotates all changes to the project to improve next projects
- Responsible for activities: organizing / planning treasure hunts - compiles the report- organizes meetings -
- meets every 15 days or when it is necessary

Treasure hunt

- Each country chooses its own treasure (the Wonder): monument, landscape, food, book, famous person
- This, will be LATER the subject of the WebQuest
- The partners will receive a puzzle to do (a map)
- To gain the clues of the puzzle they will have to solve some crossword, games... about the culture, food, monuments and other things of that country
- This will allow the partners to know better the culture of the country.
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- Once they have solved all the games, and they have received the puzzle and composed the map, they will have to find the place using Google Earth.
- Finally they will have to solve the WebQuest that the country had prepared.
- The final product of each country will be the report of the WebQuest

How can the students gain the next step

- Each time they solve some games, they will receive the next step using email /skype
- That's why each country must have at least an email address for this
- There will be a group of students responsible for this task
